Dress Code

Students are expected to adhere to standards of cleanliness and dress that are compatible with the requirement of a productive school environment.

A student's appearance or mode of dress will not be permitted to disrupt the educational process or constitute a threat to health or safety. When in the judgement of the principal, a student's appearance or mode of dress disrupts the educational process or constitutes a threat to health or safety, the student may be required to modify his or her dress. In partial attainment of the foregoing, a student must 1) groom hair so that it is clean and safe for any school activity in which he or she will partake, 2) use footwear and 3) wear attire which is not distracting or does not promote or seem to promote the use of alcohol, tobacco or illegal substances and is not vulgar, profane or derogatory.
