Principal's Report

Education:

- March 5th was an all-day in-service for all teachers district wide. KES teachers spent the morning collaborating with WCSU teachers to analyze assessment data and to review the relevance of the data in informing curriculum and instruction. The afternoon reconvened at KES to analyze school-based data pertaining to student behavior, family engagement, and school climate. In both of these professional development opportunities, KES teachers expressed their dedication not only to their professional responsibilities as educators but also to their community of students at Killington Elementary School.
- KES Trailblazers' ski/ride program has had a banner year so far. We are most grateful for our more than 40 volunteers who make it possible to put more than 80 children on the Killington Resort terrain for 9 winter Thursdays.
